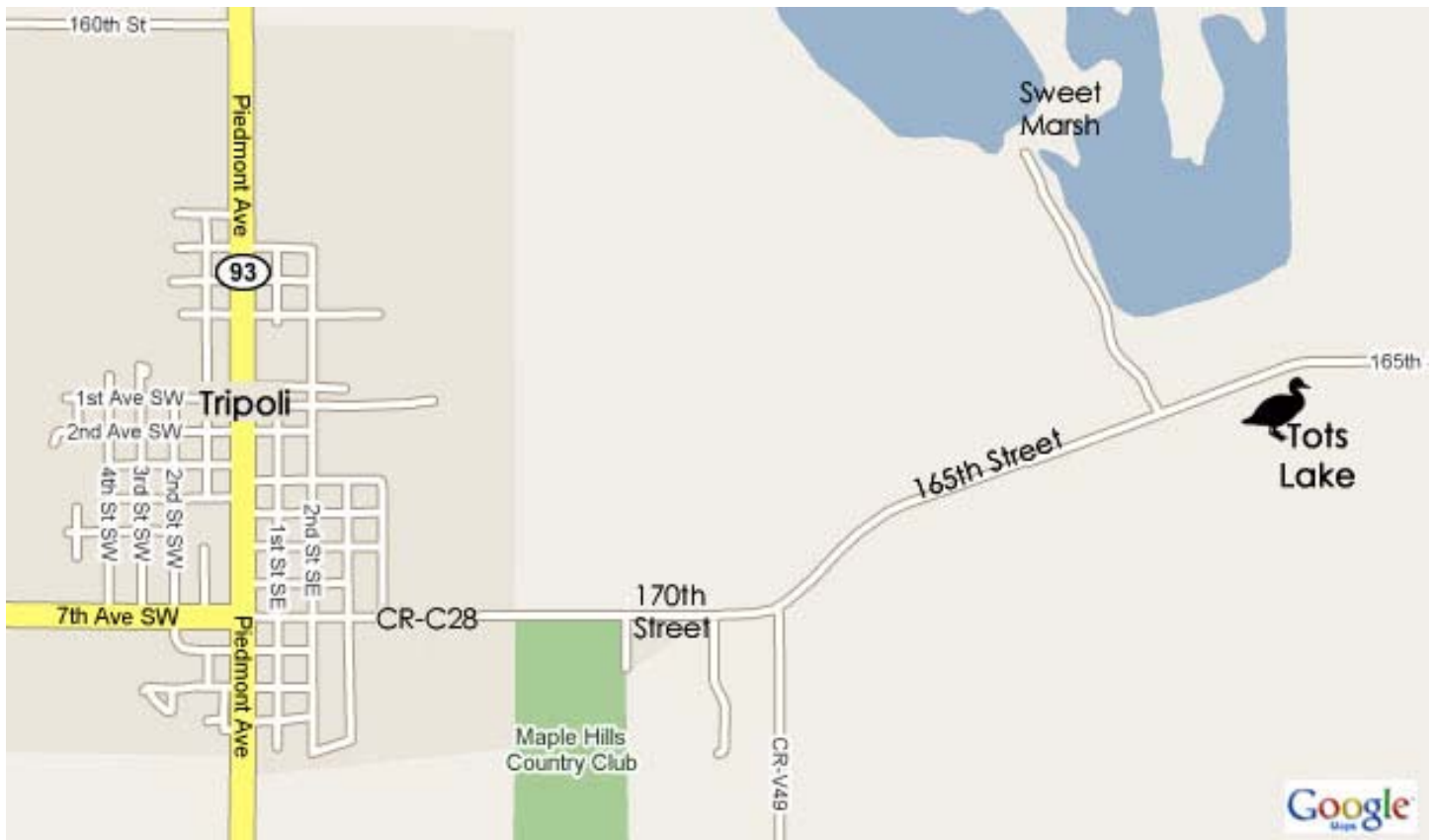
Each participant will receive a Project Webfoot Kit with \$300 worth of classroom materials, including:
